

WHAT DOES A PROXY MEAN TO YOU?

Florida law allows for homeowners to use a proxy to vote on their behalf if the resident is unable to attend the Annual Membership Meeting. This would be someone you appoint who would have your authority to represent you at the meeting and vote on your behalf. If you do not know someone to appoint, you are allowed to designate a member of the HOA Board. Such voting would include Board elections, Bylaws amendments, or any other items requiring a vote.

If you are unable to attend the Annual Membership Meeting set for 7pm on February 21, 2023, at the live meeting at the Gray Memorial United Methodist Church located at 2201 Old Bainbridge Road, and would like to have a vote in the matters before the Board, then you must complete the information below and then return this form to a current member of the Board listed below before **February 20**.
